Uniform, Mr Bill - I believe that there has been some confusion regarding school uniform following my communication at the start of this half-term. To clarify, on days when children are doing any form of outdoor learning (forest school, gardening, eco work or PE) pupils should be dressed in their school PE kit. Our PE kit consists of navy blue tracksuit bottoms or shorts and a white t-shirt (with or without a collar). In colder weather, or for certain activities, a navy blue long sleeved top and a waterproof layer may be required. Please note that for forest school, navy blue jogging bottoms are better than shorts as the children may be venturing into long vegetation.

Sports Days, Mr. Bill - We are currently exploring what we will be able to organise in terms of a sports day this year. On 15th June, the DfE emailed all schools with a change of guidance relating to summer activities. We are putting together a plan and risk assessment and I should be in a position to share this with you next week.
