Dear Parents/Carers,

We would like to warmly welcome you all back to our last half term of this academic year. We will be working hard to build on the progress that our pupils made last half term with a particular focus on improving the quality of writing - in many cases this has been the area most impacted by the recent lost learning. You will no doubt be pleased to hear that the teachers are currently preparing end of year reports for your child/ren, and these will give you an accurate picture of the standards that your child is currently working at and areas for further development.

There are a three other important points that I would like to bring to your attention:

- **Attendance** – please see our updated attendance policy here: <https://www.leighbransford.worcs.sch.uk/wp-content/uploads/2021/06/LB-Attendance-Policy.pdf> . You will notice that we have clearly defined thresholds of attendance that result in pre-defined actions. I am pleased to say that attendance is currently good for most groups here and we would like to keep it that way.
- **Uniform** – We think that it is important for our pupils to look smart in order that they perform at their best with a positive attitude to learning. Therefore please ensure that your child comes to school in the correct uniform. Details can be found here: <https://www.leighbransford.worcs.sch.uk/parents/school-uniform> . We have noticed that PE and outdoor learning days are the days when we have the greatest mix of clothing. In order to standardise this matter we are asking that on PE days **and outdoor learning days** pupils should wear the agreed school PE kit. Our PE kit should consist of navy blue track suit bottom/shorts and a white t-shirt. In colder weather a navy blue fleece and a waterproof top may be required. As has been the case during this period your children will need to come to school dressed for PE or outdoor learning on the relevant days.
- **Parking on Hoopers Close (Zig Zags)** – It has been reported to me by concerned parents that we have members of our school community regularly parking on the zig zag markings. In the interests of safety I need to request that you stop doing this. At peak times the zig zags are essential to allow space for the turning circle to function properly. If cars are struggling to turn around then accidents can happen and I am sure that nobody would want their parking to be the cause of injury or trauma to anyone here.
